

Valbuk - 2012-2014



Scope

Initiated by the ECAP Foundation, the Valbuk is a Leonardo da Vinci project, under the Lifelong learning programme. 8 countries are partners: Switzerland (leader), Austria, Italy, France, the Netherlands, Germany and Slovenia.

Objectives

The main goal of the Valbuk is to implement and use ECVET principles in order to facilitate access to lifelong learning and qualifications of migrant workers in an emblematic sector, cleaning services. A solid and competent consortium, including stakeholders of CVET and the owner of the original model to be transferred (3S-Austria), will design a VQTS Matrix of competences taking into account the needs identified by the market (employers and users) and will test this tool among professionals (employers and employees).

Results

- a VQTS Matrix in order to compare existing qualifications in the cleaning services sector, define a shared competence Matrix declined in units of learning outcomes (areas of competences),
- EQF levels and steps of development of the competences on the basis of complexity of knowledge and skills, autonomy and responsibility, related to activities included in the Matrix;
- Guidelines and related procedures for the completion of a flexible and modular qualification pathway based on the Matrix;
- operational partnerships involving stakeholders and key actors in the cleaning sector and employment of migrant workers ;
- raising awareness of ECVET potentialities in the cleaning sector;
