# BBQ Dinner and 'Spicy Jazz', Campus Lake



Spicy Jazz is a versatile Midlands-based jazz band. Formed in 1981, the six piece band includes the front line of Bob Jackson (trombone and vocals), Tony Pipkin (trumpet and flugel horn), Zoltan Sagi (soprano, alto and tenor saxophones and clarinet) and rhythm section of Roger Heeley (piano), Steve Kershaw (double bass) and Roy Dutton (drums). Zoltan Sagi has just rejoined the band after 3 years 'on the road' as featured soloist with the Big Chris Barber Band. Spicy Jazz have accompanied many of Britain's top 'mainstream' jazz musicians, including the late Humphrey Lyttelton.
